

1	<b>Feb 19 (Sat)</b>	Depart USA to Tel Aviv. Overnight en route	
2	<b>Feb 20 (Sun)</b>	Arrive in Israel in the late morning. Explore <b>Jaffa</b> , the ancient port city from which Jonah set sail, and which Peter visited – raising Tabitha from the dead and receiving the vision of the descending sheet (Acts 10). Rest up after the transatlantic flight and enjoy the beautiful Mediterranean beach front in Netanya.	<b>Netanya, Medi Terre Hotel</b> or similar
3	<b>Feb 21 (Mon)</b>	Visit the <b>Israel College of the Bible</b> to learn about the current Messianic movement in Israel, and here testimonies from Arab and Jewish believers in Yeshua. Visit Herod's impressive port of <b>Caesarea</b> . Here Roman governors such as Pontius Pilate, Felix (Acts 24) and Festus (Acts 26) ruled, the Roman Centurion Cornelius received the gospel, and Paul made his famous defense before King Agrippa. Continue to <b>Mount Carmel</b> , site of Elijah's contest with the prophets of Baal. Explore the Old Testament city of <b>Megiddo</b> , which gives its name to "Armageddon" of Revelation 16:16.	<b>Sea of Galilee – Ron Beach Hotel</b> or similar
4	<b>Feb 22 (Tues)</b>	Spend the morning around the Sea of Galilee, visiting the <b>Mount of Beatitudes</b> , traditional site of the Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5-7) and Jesus' ministry base at <b>Capernaum</b> . Enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and view the ancient <b>fishing boat</b> from the time of Yeshua, found by the shore of the plain of Gennesaret. Lunch is traditional <b>St. Peter's fish</b> (included). End the day with a visit to <b>Nazareth</b> , the boyhood home of Jesus. Learn about life in a Jewish agricultural village 2000 years ago by visiting "Nazareth Village".	<b>Sea of Galilee – Ron Beach Hotel</b> or similar

5	<b>Feb 23 (Wed)</b>	Begin the day with a nature hike at <b>Caesarea Philippi</b> , site of Jesus' question to his disciples: "Who do men say that I am?" (Matt. 16). Ascend the <b>Golan Heights</b> where we will visit the Ben-Tal lookout over the Syrian border and discuss the battles in the area during the 1967 and 1973 wars. End the day at the <b>Jordan River</b> where there will be an opportunity for baptisms.	<b>Sea of Galilee – Ron Beach Hotel</b> or similar
6	<b>Feb 24 (Thurs)</b>	Follow the Jordan River down to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. Visit Qumran, where the <b>Dead Sea Scrolls</b> were found and then continue south to take a short hike at the oasis of <b>Ein Gedi</b> , where David hid from Saul. Ride the cable car up to <b>Masada</b> , where the last Jewish defenders held out against the Romans. There will be an opportunity to float in the mineral-rich waters of the <b>Dead Sea</b> .	<b>Dead Sea, Crowne Plaza</b> or similar
7	<b>Feb 25 (Fri)</b>	Travel through the Negev, with its varied ethnic communities. We will explore <b>Tel Sheva</b> , the ancient mound of Biblical Beer Sheva. Abraham planted at tamarisk tree during his sojourn there. Continue to the Judean lowlands, stopping at the Valley of Elah where <b>David fought Goliath</b> , and then continue to <b>Bethlehem</b> and the nearby shepherds' fields. Ascend to Jerusalem, for our first glimpse of the Holy City from the Haas Promenade. <i>"Our feet are standing in your gates, O Jerusalem"</i> (Psalm 122:2).	<b>Jerusalem, Dan Panorama (deluxe rooms)</b> or similar
8	<b>Feb 26 (Sat)</b>	From the top of the <b>Mount of Olives</b> there is a breathtaking panorama over the Old City of Jerusalem. As you descend the hill, remember that Jesus often travelled this descent and taught his disciples along the way (Matt 24, 25). Pause in the gardens of " <b>Dominus Flevit</b> " and remember his weeping over the city during his triumphal entry. Take some time to meditate in the <b>Garden of Gethsemane</b> . Visit the <b>Pools of Bethesda</b> (John 5), where Jesus healed the man paralyzed 38 years, and then explore the Old City. There will be free time in the bazaars of the Old City, or to visit some additional sites. Continue to the <b>Israel Museum</b> , which houses the <b>Dead Sea Scrolls</b> and a marvelous 1:50 scale <b>model of Jerusalem</b> at the time of Jesus.	<b>Jerusalem, Dan Panorama (deluxe rooms)</b> or similar
9	<b>Feb 27 (Sun)</b>	Ascend <b>Temple Mount</b> , where the holy temple once stood, now the site of the Muslim shrines of the Dome of the Rock and the Al-Aqsa Mosque. Visit <b>the Jewish Quarter</b> , viewing the extensive archaeological excavations that have unearthed a wall built by King Hezekiah,	<b>Dan Panorama (deluxe rooms)</b> or similar

mansions from the time of Jesus (housed in the **Wohl Museum**), and the **Davidson Center**, Herod's monumental entranceway to the Temple. Take time to pray at the **Western Wall**. Visit the **City of David**, the earliest part of Jerusalem, which David conquered from the Jebusites, exploring the Canaanite water system and the water tunnel King Hezekiah dug at the time of the Assyrian siege. Tour the **Garden Tomb**, a peaceful place for our group to reflect on the Lord's death and resurrection and share communion together before our departure home. There will also be an opportunity to visit **the Friends of Zion Museum**.

- 9 **Feb 28 (Mon)** There will be an optional excursion to Yad VaShem, the Holocaust Memorial Museum. In the early afternoon, our bus will take us to the airport for flights home, with amazing memories of Israel and the Land of the Bible.

- Airfare. Please do not book your tickets until the tour has gathered the minimum number of participants to be **GUARANTEED DEPARTURE**.
- Medical Insurance valid in Israel, including coverage for COVID19-related hospitalization
- Travel Cancellation Insurance for entire tour package, including airfare costs
- Lunches (except on Day 4) and other expenses not mentioned in the itinerary
- Transfers to and from the airport **for those arriving too late, or departing too early, to join the group bus**

**PAYMENT SCHEDULE AND CANCELLATION PENALTIES**

The deposit of **\$200** at the time of **registration** is **non-refundable** (UNLESS the tour is cancelled for lack of participants, or due to renewed COVID-19 restrictions by the Israeli government that make the tour impossible. In these cases a full refund of the deposit will be given).

Registration closes **Nov 19, 2021**

The final payment is due by **Dec 19, 2021**

25% of the total tour cost will be charged if cancellation occurs 60-45 days prior to departure

50% of the total tour cost will be charged if cancellation occurs 44-15 days prior to departure

100% of the total tour cost will be charged if cancellation occurs 14-0 days prior to departure

### TRAVEL INSURANCE

We strongly advise you to purchase **travel cancellation insurance** for your trip to Israel. Travel insurance usually covers your expenses in case of cancellation due to individual health issues or emergencies in your immediate family. Check your policy carefully before purchase to be informed of what it includes, in particular that it includes coverage if you are not able to travel, due to COVID19-like symptoms. You should also purchase **medical insurance** valid overseas for the duration of your time in Israel, including coverage for COVID19-related hospitalization and treatment and/or isolation.

### DOCUMENTS

A valid passport for at least **six months** after returning home is required. It is the passenger's responsibility to obtain, at their own expense, the documents required to enter Israel according to citizenship. Those traveling on US and Canadian passports are not required to obtain visas in advance for entering Israel.

### PARTICIPANT MOBILITY

Unfortunately, many sites on the itinerary are not accessible to people in wheelchairs or those who have limited mobility. If there are any issues pertaining to your health or physical fitness, we ask that you consult with us prior to registration.

### ACKNOWLEDGMENT

**Currently, all tourists entering Israel are required to be vaccinated for COVID19. If you are not vaccinated, and do not plan to be vaccinated before October 2021, we recommend that you wait to register until the Israeli government rescinds this requirement. In the near future, it may also be possible to take a serology test to demonstrate antibodies after recovering from COVID19.**
