Dallas Theological Seminary and Israel College of the Bible invite you to join an in-depth study tour focusing on the geography of the Land of the Bible.

ITINERARY

DAY	DATE	PROGRAM	OVERNIGHT
1	March 12 (Sunday)	Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport and transfer to our hotel in Netanya	Netanya, Residence Hotel or similar
2	March 13 (Monday)	Attend an Introductory Lecture at the Israel College of the Bible: <i>Overview of the Geography of the Land of the Bible</i> . A complimentary lunch will be provided this day. Tour Caesarea Maritima , where the centurion Cornelius heard the gospel and Paul stood trial before governors Felix and Festus (Acts 24 and 26). Continue to Mt. Carmel , symbol of beauty in biblical poetry, where Elijah called a contest with the prophets of Baal and Asherah.	Netanya, Residence Hotel or similar
3	March 14 (Tuesday)	Travel to Megiddo , on the western fringe of the Jezreel Valley, and discuss its important roll throughout the biblical period and its supposed connection with New Testament Armageddon. Continue to Tel Jezreel , site of Ahab and Jezebel's summer palace (1 Kings 21), and Gideon's Spring (Judges 7), where he tested his men. Nazareth is nestled below the hilly ridge on the north side of the Jezreel Valley. So many well-known bible stories took place in the surrounding area: the wedding at Cana, the battle between Deborah, Barak and the Canaanite forces (Judges 5), the raising of both the Shunamite woman's son and the son of the Widow of Nain. Visit Nazareth Village , a reenactment of life in first century Nazareth. At the end of the day relax overlooking the Sea of Galilee. Evening Lecture : The Geography of the Conquest and Judges.	Sea of Galilee, Ohalo Guest House
4	March 15 (Wednesday)	Tour Tel Hazor , the northern Canaanite town that headed the opposition to Joshua (Joshua 11). At Tel Dan enjoy a pleasant stroll along the stream to the ancient temple where the Jeroboam I set up one of the Golden Calves (1 Kings 12). Hike the region of Caesarea Philippi (Matt 16:13). Evening Lecture: Geography of the Gospels.

5	March 16 (Thursday)	Today we spend the day around the beautiful Sea of Galilee, focusing on the geography of Jesus' ministry. Visit the traditional Mt. of Beatitudes and Peter's Fishing Place at Tabgha. Tour Capernaum (his ministry base), and Magdala (home of Mary Magdalene) In the afternoon visit Kursi and discuss the possible locations of the casting out of demons from the man who dwelt among the tombs. Evening Lecture: The United and Divided Monarchies	Sea of Galilee, Ohalo Guest House
6	March 17 (Friday)	Follow the Jordan River to the area near Jericho where Yeshua was baptized by John. Stop in the Judean Wilderness to remember temptation of Yeshua, and the setting for his parable of the Good Samaritan. Then, up to Jerusalem! Tour the City of David excavations, Hezekiah's tunnel (alternatively, the Canaanite Tunnel) and the Pool of Siloam . Visit Bethlehem to visit the traditional area of the "shepherd's fields". Welcome in the Sabbath together. Evening Lecture: Jerusalem in the Second Temple Period	Jerusalem, Eyal Hotel, or similar
7	March 18 (Saturday)	Enjoy a panoramic view over the city from the Mt. of Olives and then begin our study of the geography of Jerusalem, from its beginnings as a small Canaanite city state until the time it became Visit the traditional Garden of Gethsemane , and then take a walking tour through the Old City , stopping at the Pools of Bethesda (John 5), the Church of the Holy Sepulcher and the Garden Tomb . In the afternoon, travel to Herodion (Herod the Great's palace and burial place). Free evening.	Jerusalem, Eyal Hotel or similar
8	March 19 (Sunday)	Learn about destructions, resettlement and subsequent growth of Jerusalem. Sites will include Tour the " Herodian Mansions " (the Wohl Museum) - the remains of first century homes, the Southwall Excavations and the Davidson Center . Stop at the Western Wall and then explore the Western Wall Tunnels . The afternoon is free for shopping in the Old City markets, walking on the Old City walls or visiting other sites of interest. Transfer to the airport for flights home.	No hotel included this night

- Passport and visa fees if applicable (US citizens do not need to pay for Israeli visas, which are given upon entrance to Israel)
- Lunches (except the one mentioned in the itinerary)
- Sodas and alcohol at the hotels or the fish lunch
- All expenses of a personal nature, including COVID19-related tests that may be required before flights, or when entering Israel or returning to your home country.

BOOKINGS AND RATES

- This tour requires a minimum of 15 paying participants for the quoted prices to be available. In case of less passengers as of the day registration closes (Dec. 12, 2022), notification will be given regarding the increase in price per passenger, or the itinerary and/or hotels will be altered. Alternatively, the tour will with be cancelled and a full refund given.
- **Please do not book your flights until the minimum number of participants is reached and “guaranteed departure” for the tour is confirmed.**
- Changes can occur in hotels. Changes in price may also be necessary, due to exchange rate fluctuations, up to 60 days before departure.
- If a roommate cannot be assigned or is not wanted, single-room rates will apply.

- Registration closes December 12, 2022 (or earlier, if the tour is full).
- A non-refundable deposit of **\$200 per person**, paid online to Israel College of the Bible is required to secure registration. You will be directed to the payment site at the end of registration. In the case that the tour needs to be cancelled due to lack of minimum participants on the day that registration closes, your deposit will be fully refunded.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION PENALTIES

- **Final Payment** should be made by December 24, 2022. A link will be provided
- 25% of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel after January 24, 2022
- 50 % of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel after February 10, 2022.
- 100 % of total tour cost will be charged if cancellation occurs after February 24, 2022.

DOCUMENTS

A **passport valid for at least six months after returning home** is required. It is the passenger's responsibility to obtain, at their own expense, the documents required to enter Israel according to citizenship. In addition, the Israeli government may require a health declaration, proof of vaccination/recovery and a COVID19 PCR test taken within 72 hours of your flights, upon arrival in Israel and before departure from Israel (exact requirements to be updated closer to the date of departure).

PASSENGER FITNESS

Travelling in Israel requires each participant to be in good health and able to walk, as many sites are unfortunately not accessible to people in wheelchairs or those who have difficulty walking. If there are any issues pertaining to your health or physical fitness, we ask that you consult with us prior to registration.
