Evening Lecture: <i>Archaeology of the Middle Bronze and Late Bronze Periods.</i>	Neve Shalom, or similar
4	Nov 15 (Tuesday)	Continue to explore the Shephelah visiting: Tel Maresha/Beit Guvrin – tour and Dig for a Day. Tel Lakhish (Josh 10:3, 31-33; 2 Kings 18:14-17), Kh. Er-Rai (one of the suggested locations of Ziklag, 1 Sam 27:6, 30:1). Evening Lecture: Archaeology of the Iron Age	TBA, Arad or similar

5	Nov 16 (Wednesday)	Explore excavations in the Negev: Tel Sheva (Gen 21 and 26), Ein Avdat (Wilderness of Zin, Num 34:3), Avdat (Nabatean spice route), Tel Arad (Num 21:1-3). Evening Lecture: Archaeology of the Second Temple Period	TBA, Arad or similar
6	Nov 17 (Thursday)	Climb the Roman Ramp at Masada , to explore one of Herod's wilderness fortresses, and setting of the last stand of Jewish rebels against the Romans in 73 CE. Explore the oasis of Ein Gedi with its pools and waterfalls, including hiking up to the Chalcolithic temple. Tour Qumran find spot of the Dead Sea Scrolls. End the day with a float in the Dead Sea and then, UP TO JERUSALEM! Evening Lecture: <i>Archaeology of the Life of Yeshua</i>	Jerusalem, St. Andrews Guest House, or similar
7	Nov 18 (Friday)	Participate in the Temple Mount Sifting Project . Tour the Israel Museum , viewing the model of Second Period Jerusalem, the Shrine of the book (where portions of the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed, and a guided tour of the archaeology wing. In the afternoon, there will be an optional walking tour of the Old City or free time to browse the Old City bazaars.	Jerusalem,

BOOKINGS AND RATES

- This tour requires a minimum of 15 paying participants for the quoted prices to be available. In case of less passengers, notification will be given regarding the increase in price per passenger, or the itinerary and/or hotels will be altered. Alternatively, the tour will with be cancelled and a full refund given.
- **Please do not book your flights until “guaranteed departure” for the tour is confirmed.**
- Changes can occur in hotels, along with changes in price due to exchange rate fluctuations.
- If a roommate cannot be assigned or is not wanted, single-room rates will apply.

- A non-refundable deposit of **\$200 per person**, paid online, to Israel College of the Bible is required to secure registration. You will be directed to the payment site at the end of registration. In the case that the tour needs to be cancelled due to lack of minimum participants on the day that registration closes your deposit will be fully refunded.

DOCUMENTS

A passport valid for at least **six months after returning home** is required. It is the passenger's responsibility to obtain, at their own expense, the documents required to enter Israel according to citizenship. In addition, the Israeli government may require a health declaration, proof of vaccination/recovery and a COVID19 PCR test taken within 72 hours of your flights, upon arrival in Israel and before departure from Israel (exact requirements to be updated closer to the date of departure).

Travelling in Israel requires each participant to be in good health and able to walk, as many sites are unfortunately not accessible to people in wheelchairs or those who have difficulty walking. If there are any issues pertaining to your health or physical fitness, we ask that you consult with us prior to registration.
