0	June 4 Sunday	Depart for Israel	In flight
1	June 5 Monday	Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport (AA flight arriving about 19:00) and transfer to your hotel in Netanya.	Netanya, Seasons Hotel or similar
2	June 6 Tuesday	Visit ONE FOR ISRAEL's headquarters and the Israel College of the Bible . Tour Caesarea Maritima , where the centurion Cornelius heard the gospel and Paul stood trial before governors Felix and Festus (Acts 24 and 26). Visit Ebenezer Messianic Seniors home in Haifa. Continue to Mt. Carmel , symbol of beauty in biblical poetry, where Elijah called a contest with the prophets of Baal and Asherah. Travel to Megiddo , on the western fringe of the Jezreel Valley, and discuss its important roll throughout the Biblical period and its supposed connection with New Testament Armageddon. 3	June 7 Wed	Tour Tel Hazor , the northern Canaanite town that headed the opposition to Joshua (Joshua 11). At Tel Dan enjoy a pleasant stroll along the stream to the ancient temple where the Jeroboam I set up one of the golden calves (1 Kings 12). Enjoy the beautiful region of Caesarea Philippi (Matt 16:13). Ascend by the ski lift to Mt Hermon .	Sea of Galilee, Maagan Eden or similar

4	June 8 Thursday	Today we spend the day around the beautiful Sea of Galilee, focusing on Yeshua’s ministry years. Visit the traditional Mt. of Beatitudes, Chorazin (a town where Yeshua frequently ministered) and the Church of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes at Tabgha. Enjoy a fish lunch near the Sea of Galilee (included). In the afternoon Stop at “Peter’s Fishing Place” and tour Capernaum (his ministry base), as well as Magdala (home of Mary Magdalene). Visit Kursi and discuss the possible locations of the casting out of demons from the man who dwelt among the tombs.	Sea of Galilee, Maagan Eden or similar
5	June 9 Friday	Visit Cana in Galilee, the site of Yeshua’s first miracle, Tour Nazareth Village , a reenactment of life in first century Nazareth. At the end at Tzipori , once the capital of the Galilee, with its rich layers of Jewish history.	Sea of Galilee, Maagan Eden or similar
6	June 10 Saturday	Start the day with a panoramic view over the Sea of Galilee from Mt. Arbel . Attend a Messianic service in Tiberias. The rest of the afternoon is free to relax by the Sea of Galilee.	Sea of Galilee, Maagan Eden or similar
7	June 11 Sunday	Tour Beth Shean (Scythopolis of the Decapolis) . Follow the Jordan River to Qasr el-Yahud , in the area near Jericho where Yeshua was baptized by John. Visit Qumran to learn about the Dead Sea Scrolls, and hike at Ein Gedi , where David hid from Saul (1 Sam 24). There will be time to float in the waters of the Dead Sea .	Dead Sea region, David Resort or similar
8	June 12 Monday	Tour Masada , Herod the Great’s wilderness palace. Stop in the Judean Wilderness to remember temptation of Yeshua, and the setting for his parable of the Good Samaritan. Have lunch and a camel ride at Genesis Land (included). Then, up to Jerusalem! Enjoy a panoramic view over the city from the Mt. of Olives . Visit the traditional Garden of Gethsemane . Stop at the Western Wall and then explore the Western Wall Tunnels .	Jerusalem, Ibis City Center hotel or similar
9	June 13 Tuesday	Tour the City of David excavations, Hezekiah’s tunnel (alternatively, the Canaanite Tunnel) and the Pool of Siloam . Visit the Southwall Excavations and the Davidson Center . In the afternoon, travel to Herodion (Herod the Great’s palace and burial place). Continue to Bethlehem to visit the traditional area of the “shepherd’s fields” .	Jerusalem, Ibis City Center hotel or similar

10	June 14 Wed	Take a walking tour through the Old City , stopping at the Pools of Bethesda (John 5), the Church of the Holy Sepulcher , the “Herodian Mansions” (the Wohl Museum - the remains of first century homes), and the Garden Tomb . Depending on the time of your flight, the rest of the day is free for shopping in the Old City markets, walking on the Old City walls or visiting other sites of interest. Transfer to the airport for flights home.	No hotel included this night
11	June 15 Thurs	Arrive home.

- Lunches (except the ones mentioned in the itinerary)
- Sodas and alcohol at the hotels
- All expenses of a personal nature

BOOKINGS AND RATES

- This tour requires a minimum of 18 paying participants for the quoted prices to be available. In case of less passengers, notification will be given regarding the increase in price per passenger (alternatively, the itinerary and/or hotels will be altered.)
- **Please do not book your flights (except for group flights) until “guaranteed departure” for the tour is confirmed.**
- Changes can occur in hotels due to factors beyond our control, as well as changes in price due to exchange rate fluctuations up until the date of final payment.
- If a roommate cannot be assigned or is not wanted, single-room rates will apply.
- A non-refundable deposit of **\$200** per person, paid online, to Israel College of the Bible is required to secure registration. You will be directed to the payment site at the end of registration. In the case that the tour needs to be cancelled due to lack of minimum participants (on the day that registration closes) your deposit will be fully refunded.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION PENALTIES

- **Final Payment** should be made by March 5, 2023
- 25 % of total cost will be charge if you cancel after April 21, 2021.
- 50 % of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel after May 5, 2023.
- 100 % of total tour cost will be charged if cancellation occurs after May 21, 2023.
